






Report on Visit to societies for awareness HAR GHAR TIRANGA

Report on Ganpati Visarjan



Around 17.4 crore children of less than five years across the country are given polio drops as part of the drive of Government of India to sustain polio eradication from the country this activity of pulse polio dose 25 volunteers from NSS Unit of Saket college were present for the activity . 125 rs given to every volunteer for this activity . a lunch box was provided to volunteers .





Figure 1 Traffic Management during Ganpat Festival




Figure 1 International Yoga Day 21 June 2020




Figure 1 Independence Day 15/8/2018
