Alumni Assisiation and WDC in association with IQAC was organized a guest lecture for girl students of saket vidyamandir on dated 8th March 2023. A student of BMS branch of Saket college Mrs.Dakshata Ranade had a guest lecture for school girls on menstruation and hygiene. She is an alumni student of Saket college and she guided girls aged 13 to 15 about the important phase of their life in a very beautiful and scientific manner.

She told students about menstruation and hygiene with help of power point presentation. She discussed about why is menstruation hygiene important, what are the elements of menstrual hygiene, What are the types of hygiene, and so on. She told Poor menstrual hygiene, however, can pose serious health risks, like reproductive and urinary tract infections which can result in future infertility and birth complications. Neglecting to wash hands after changing menstrual products can spread infections, such as hepatitis B and thrush. She also answered them that access to affordable and sustainable menstrual hygiene products (e.g. menstrual cloths, reusable pads, disposable pads, menstrual cups and tampons) is key to improving menstrual health and hygiene.

Many students openly asked her questions and she answered them satisfactorily.

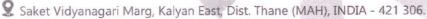
OBJECTIVE OF PROGRAM
