#### **Eligibility:**

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Bachelor of Commerce (Accounts and Finance) degree course should have passed XII std. Examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education, Pune, or its equivalent and secured not less than 45 % marks in aggregate (40% in the case of reserved category candidates) (in one attempt).
